Problem Statement
 Randomised clinical trials (RCTs) are the gold standard for evaluation of interventions, however the rigor & validity of RCTs is threatened by high rates of patient dropout.
 On average, >30% of patients drop out of Phase 3 AD trials run on the Medidata platform, and similar rates have been reported across the industry.
 At best, this leads to trial delays & increased costs; at worst, it biases trial results and reduces their applicability outside the trial.

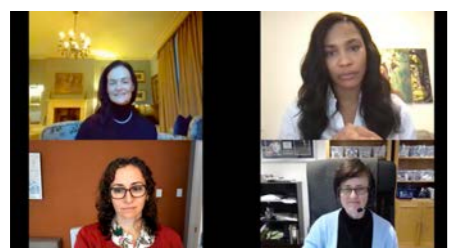
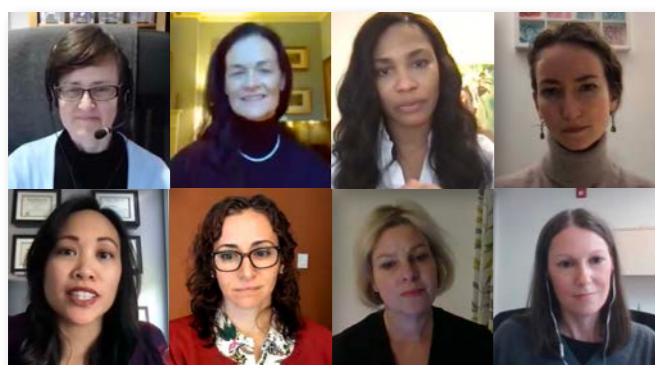

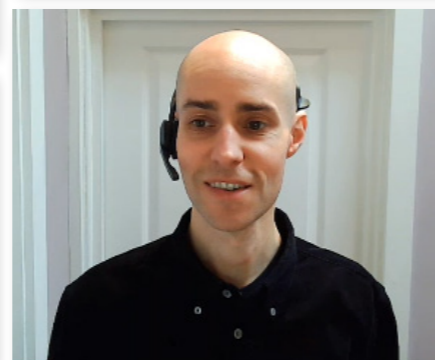
