Windsor Framework: continued preparations for implementation

We wrote on 8 August 2024 and asked you to complete a questionnaire to share how you were progressing with the labelling updates required as part of the implementation of the Windsor Framework.

Today we are sharing some further advice to support you in achieving compliance by 1 January 2025. We are also running a repeat questionnaire open until the end of October; further details are given below.

You must notify the MHRA of updated artwork requirements as soon as possible. If you have concerns about reaching compliance with the updated labelling required as part of the Windsor Framework. We will seek to work with and support MAHs if they are experiencing unforeseen challenges.

We remind MAHs that you do not need to wait for MHRA approval of self-certification submissions to proceed with the packaging updates.

1. Sharing approaches for preparedness

Respondents to the August questionnaire have shared approaches for managing completion of their submissions and preparations in advance of the implementation of the Windsor Framework. Some examples which may help you prioritise your notifications over the coming months.

- Products currently on the market can be prioritised while products not currently on sale can be completed at a later date after 1 January 2025. Updated labelling for a product only needs to be notified before a new batch is QP certified in 2025, it does not have to be done by 31 December if no new batch is planned until later.
- Some companies do not need to complete submissions at this point due to the volumes of stock currently on the market.





Some respondents have shared that they have released sufficient surplus stock to
cover the first three months of the year to act as a buffer in the case of any delays to
applying the 'UK only' labelling.

2. Implementation issues

We strongly encourage companies to contact us to discuss concerns they may have regarding the implementation of the labelling updates required as part of the Windsor Framework. We appreciate there may be unforeseen circumstances that could prevent compliance by 1 January 2025 – we are only able to help when we know specific details relating to a product or portfolio. We have supported several companies to reach a compliant pathway and we urge those with concerns to contact us.
